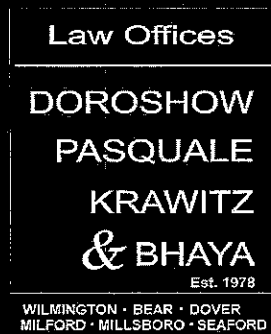

Dear Healthcare Provider:

We recently held a breakfast seminar for healthcare providers. A common question was "what is required when a patient requests a copy of his or her medical records?"

The answer to this question is found in the Delaware Administrative Code, Section 1700, Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline.

A patient who requests that a copy of his or her own medical records be transferred to another physician or be provided to the patient, may be charged a reasonable fee not to exceed the fees set forth below, excluding the actual cost of postage or shipping:

- \$2.00 per page for pages 1-10;
- \$1.00 per page for pages 11-20;
- \$0.90 per page for pages 21-60;
- \$0.50 per page for pages 61 and up.

The fees in the list apply whether the records are produced in either paper or electronic form.

For records that cannot be copied on a copier, such as radiology films, models, photographs or fetal monitoring strips, you may charge for the full cost of reproduction.

You may require payment of all costs in advance of your release of the records except for records requested to make or complete an application for a disability benefits program.
