Dear Healthcare Provider:

In order to remain certified in the Delaware Workers' Compensation Health Care Payment System, a healthcare provider must complete the state-approved course every 2 years. It is critical that you not let your certification lapse. If you do, you risk not getting your bills paid at all!

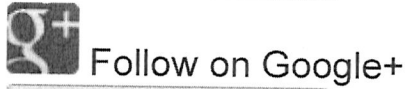
The 2014 Continuing Education Course for healthcare providers is now available. You can access it by clicking here: <http://dowc.ingenix.com/CourseLogin.asp>. The 2014 version contains updated information, including having the reading material and questions presented on the same page. The previous course is no longer available, so both new and recertifying health care providers will need to complete this course sometime before the end of the 2 year cycle. Your expiration date is tied to your professional license renewal pursuant to the 2013 regulation change. You can check on your certification expiration date on the certified provider list published by the state which can be found at <http://dia.delawareworks.com/workers-comp/hcps/provider-certification.php>.

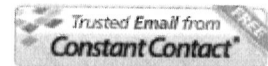
